Mackinaw Watercraft, located in Grand Ledge Michigan, is a custom boat works dedicated to creating unique treasures that enhance the outdoor experience and inspire a closer relationship to nature. They were commissioned by the Friends of the Fort Gratiot Light to create this one-of-a-kind 14' Wooden Looking Glass Touring Kayak, weighing only 28 lbs. with a 23" beam. This kayak is valued at \$5,150.00.

The Fort Gratiot Lighthouse kayak features two beautiful wood inlays - the Fort Gratiot Lighthouse and Keepers Duplex Building on the foredeck and the Great Lakes on the aft deck. Raffle tickets are just \$20 each and the raffle is limited to 500 tickets. The raffle drawing will be held on July 14, 2019 at 3:30pm during Blue Water SandFest, at 2802 Omar St. Port Huron, MI 48060 under Michigan Raffle License #R50298. You need not be present to win, but are responsible for and charges associated with pickup/delivery of the kayak.

Raffle proceeds will fund restoration of the historic buildings and grounds of the Fort Gratiot Light Station County Park.
